

MVLP LUNCHEON MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 12, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 11:55 by President Roxy Heacock. She welcomed all in attendance including the guests representing many of our sponsors.

As there were no changes to the December 8, 2025 Luncheon Meeting Minutes as previously posted on the website Roxy called for a motion to approve. Jo Ann Wilbour made the motion and Jan Arruda seconded. Motion carried.
